Commitment

Volunteer tutors have two options to work with students Mon., Tues., Thurs. from 4pm-8pm.

1. Group Tutors provide drop-in style tutoring for a minimum of 2 hours per week.
2. Individual 1:1 Tutors provide assistance to individual students in a specific subject(s) during scheduled weekly appointments for a minimum of 2 hours per week.
